The Melbourne Press Club/Trawalla Foundation Arts Journalism Scholarship

Entry Form

The Melbourne Press Club/Trawalla Foundation Arts Journalism Scholarship will be awarded to a journalist who shows excellence, creativity and originality in reporting, reviewing or critical appraisal of the visual or performing arts such as music, dance, painting, theatre and cinema. The work must have a strong Victorian connection and be published or broadcast in Victoria during the period **1 July 2007 to 30 June 2008**. The scholarship winner will receive \$7500 in travel costs to attend an international arts festival, event or facility selected in conjunction with Trawalla.

Entrants are invited to submit a portfolio of a maximum of 10 pieces of work. They must nominate the **three principal pieces of work** for consideration by the judges.

Entrants must also include a one-page submission nominating an international arts festival/event/facilities they would like to visit and outline how this would enhance their capacity to report, review or appraise the arts.

Other requirements and conditions are outlined in the rules and criteria at www.pressclubonline.com and entrants signing this form agree to be bound by those rules.

Entries Close at 5pm Friday 29 August 2008 and must be on a copy of this official entry form, which can be downloaded from the MPC website: www.pressclubonline.com

Five copies of the work entered are required for each entry.
